How can Assisters help incarceration facilities?



Assisters save facilities money by reducing recidivism rates. 12 months after release, eligible enrollees have 16% fewer detentions and stay out of jail longer than those without health coverage.



Assisters save staff time by working with Justice Involved individuals to access health coverage upon release from incarceration.
