

## Forms 1095-A and 1095-B Tax Information Sheet

IRS Forms 1095-A and 1095-B are forms that are used and referenced when filing your taxes and reflect your enrollment information from the tax year. Form 1095-A will assist you in filling out IRS Form 8962, which is required to be included with your tax return if you received premium assistance in 2018. Individuals who did not receive premium assistance in 2018, and purchased a health plan through the federal marketplace in 2018, can use Form 8962 to see if they should have received premium assistance.

These 1095 forms will be mailed out to each consumer no later than January 31, 2019. You may give this form to your tax professional when filing your taxes.

### For what are forms 1095-A and 1095-B used?

- Form 1095-A: This form is for consumers who have purchased a Qualified Health Plan through the federal marketplace. These forms are sent on a *tax household* level, meaning all members of the household will be included on one form.
- Form 1095-B: This form is for consumers who have Medicaid. These forms are sent on an *individual* level, meaning each individual enrolled in Medicaid will receive his or her own form.

### Why did I get multiple forms?

Multiple forms will be issued if one of the following:

- **There was a change in primary subscriber for the policy**
- **There was a change in plans**
- **Different members of the household were enrolled in different plans**

### What if I do not receive my tax forms?

You should have your 1095-A and/or 1095-B Forms by February 7, 2019. If you have not received your forms by then, please call the Kentucky Health Benefit Exchange Tax Hotline at 1-844-373-2417 and follow the instructions. You may also call this number if your form is incorrect or if there is a wrong address.
